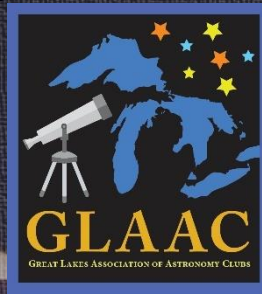


## The Great American Total Eclipse of 2017

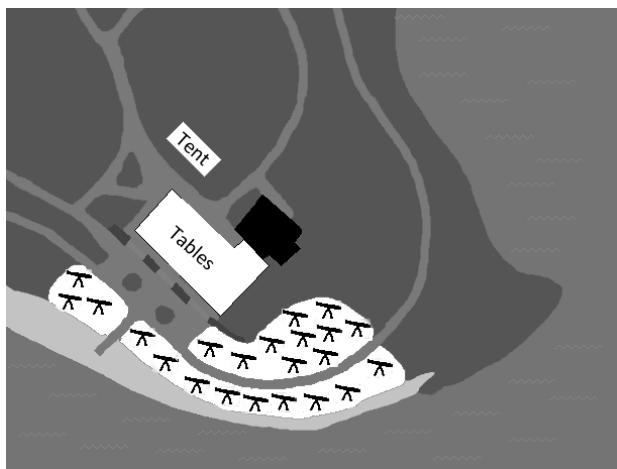
